Colour

Deep red with vibrant purple hues.

Aroma

The bouquet displays dark chocolate and black cherries with hints of cassis, cedar box and mint.

Palate

At the front of the palate lively dark fruits burst in the mouth along with chocolate and liquorice. The smoothness of the palate relies on intense flavours combined with fine tannins and balanced acidity, ending in a lingering finish.

Food Matching

Beef Bourguignon or an Indian goat curry.

Cellaring

This wine is offering great vibrancy and freshness now, but will also develop beautifully with age.

Wine summary

Cabernet Sauvignon is Coonawarra's pre-eminent grape variety. Parcels of premium fruit are selected, fermented and then aged in French oak barriques to produce this full-bodied and richly flavoured wine.
