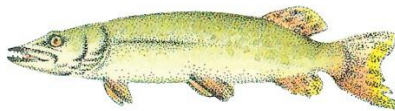


PIKES

2015 “EASTSIDE” SHIRAZ

Colour: Medium to deep red.

Aroma: Displaying our typical dark cherry and blueberry fruit with hints of grilled meat, graphite and some subtle spicy notes. Also has just a touch of charry French oak lurking around in the background.

Palate: The medium bodied palate has layers of juicy black cherry and blueberry initially, with perhaps a little plum and graphite there too, before fine savoury tannins kick in at the end.

Summary: Clare Valley Shiraz does tend to live in the shadow cast by our southern colleagues in the Barossa and McLaren Vale, but we produce terrific medium bodied wines year after year that age slowly and gracefully and, in many instances, at a fraction of the price. Delicious to drink now and the next 7 -10 years. Try this with slow cooked lamb shoulder.

100% Clare Valley GI – Estate grown single vineyard wine.
