2012 Ad Hoc Mix Master Red

- Shiraz, Grenache, Viognier, Mataro -

"Well mixed red"

The vintage: Relatively shorter than previous years. A warm season with early rainfall, left the fruit to develop and ripen. A very moderate lead-up to harvest allowed the Frankland vines to produce fruit with expressive Grenache flavours and complex tannin structure.

The winemaking: Various fruit was selected from a number of sites across W.A. to suit the very simple wine-making style. Prior to bottling, grapes were de-stemmed and fermented for 7-10 days with very light extraction.

The wine: It's a bright crimson-purple wine with a subtle aroma of berries, together with a graphite component courtesy of the Mataro. A soft, bright and juicy wine. The red and black fruits shine through for a rounded finish.

Drink with: Spaghetti alla puttanesca.
