Pinot Noir displays all the elegance of the variety, with supple cherry and plum fruits over a light dry mouthfeel.

Winemaking Notes

Harvested at optimum ripeness and fermented on skins at cool-moderate temperature. We have kept the oak influence to a minimum, allowing the vibrant fruit characters to remain to the fore.
