Tasting Note

Chain of Fire Merlot tastes ripe and fruitful, with soft tannins and a pleasing finish.

Winemaking Notes

Harvested at optimum ripeness and fermented on skins at moderate temperature. A small portion was matured in old French oak for 12 months prior to blending and bottling.

Alc/vol: 13.5%
