2014 CABERNET MERLOT

Frankland River's mild summers and reliable springs combined with cooling breezes coming off the Indian and Southern Oceans provide ideal conditions for development of the detailed flavour and fine tannins that makes great blends of Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot.

Vibrant and fruitful, this is a classic example of the cabernet merlot blend, with dark berries and plum fruit coupled with fine tannins and delicious texture.

Varieties: Cabernet Sauvignon (85%) and Merlot (15%)

Regions: Frankland River, Western Australia

Vintage: 2014 - A very good vintage providing excellent varietal definition.

Winemaking: Hand picked, long cool ferment on skins, short French

oak contact prior to blending and bottling.

Drink: Now to 2020 with barbecued meats.
