2014 SAUVIGNON BLANC SEMILLON

Margaret River and Great Southern's mild summers and reliable springs combined with cooling breezes coming off the Indian and Southern Oceans provide ideal conditions for development of the detailed flavour and fresh acidity that makes great blends of Sauvignon Blanc and Semillon.

Vibrant and juicy, this is pale in colour yet full in flavour, displaying fresh herbal notes, citrus fruits and gentle, refreshing acidity.

Varieties: Sauvignon Blanc (85%) and Semillon (15%)

Vintage: 2014 - A very good vintage providing excellent varietal definition.

Winemaking: Night harvested, crushed, de-stemmed, small amount

of skin-contact, no oak maturation.

Drink: Now to 2016 with oysters, prawns and most other shellfish.

Alcohol: 12.5%
