Chardonnay 2010

Established in 1858, the Oatley family's Craigmoor is the oldest of Mudgee's Vineyards.

Mudgee was first settled as an agricultural region in 1821 and the first vineyard was planted by Adam Roth in 1858, set amongst picturesque vines and gum trees on the banks of the Eurunderee Creek.

Roth was one of a number of German 'vine dressers' brought to Australia by William Macarthur as skilled labour for his vineyard at Camden near Sydney, the first winery in the country.

Mudgee's Craigmoor winery remains in its original state and still houses much of the early winemaking equipment.

Craigmoor Chardonnay celebrates the region's most successful white grape varietal – it's both the most widely planted and most popular in sales terms. Our Chardonnay vineyards date back forty years and range in altitude from 450 to 550 metres.

TASTING NOTE

Colour: White gold.

Aroma: Distinctive ripe peach and melon aromas with nuances of oak. Flavour: Mouthfilling and generous, this is a fruit-driven style, with light oak influence and a sustained finish. Enjoy now to 2015.
