## *Sauvignon Blanc 2011*

Established in 1858, the Oatley family's Craigmoor is the oldest of Mudgee's Vineyards.

Mudgee was first settled as an agricultural region in 1821 and the first vineyard was planted by Adam Roth in 1858, set amongst picturesque vines and gum trees on the banks of the Eurunderee Creek.

Roth was one of a number of German 'vine dressers' brought to Australia by William Macarthur as skilled labour for his vineyard at Camden near Sydney, the first winery in the country.

Mudgee's Craigmoor winery remains in its original state and still houses much of the early winemaking equipment.

Craigmoor Sauvignon Blanc sees us depart from our home region of Mudgee to that of Western Australia – our country's most successful region for this varietal. (It's a little to warm out in the central west of NSW.) Our winemakers have produced a terrific version of this popular varietal, where freshness and vitality are the key.

### TASTING NOTE

*Colour: Pale straw.*

*Aroma: Tropical fruit notes including passionfruit and guava. Gentle hints of straw.*

*Flavour: Bright and juicy, with generous fruit salad flavours, crisp and dry. Enjoy now to 2013.*
