

2015 Rosé

Aroma:

Ripe strawberries, sweet red cherries and cinnamon.

Palate:

Strawberries and cream, dry and fresh.

Comments:

Vibrant strawberry fruits burst from the glass and on the front palate. The palate then dries off to become clean and refreshed.

Viticulture:

Grown on a north-facing-bank of the Derwent River, the pinot noir used in this wine comes from a 22-year-old cool-climate vineyard north of Hobart.

The soils are permeable loams over limestone with a climate ideal for delicate wine grape production.

Winemaking:

Made from 100% pinot noir with 6 hours on skins under inert gas, then pressed to tank for cool fermentation. This wine has been handled so as to preserve the primary fruit characters and light phenolics that define this dry rosé style.
