2012 CABERNET SHIRAZ

BLEND: 70% Cabernet Sauvignon, 30% Shiraz

REGION: Central Ranges NSW

HARVEST: Late March - early April 2012

WINEMAKING: Picked and then warm fermented separately.

To retain the full juicy fruit palate, these wines had minimal oak maturation (6 months only on French oak).

Several parcels were then blended to achieve best mix of fruit, tannin and palate weight.

BOTTLED: October 2013

WINEMAKER: Debbie Lauritz

APPEARANCE: Crimson red with purple edges.

AROMA: Red berry, blackcurrant and plum fruits and red fruit characters with great complexity and depth.

PALATE: Complex red fruits balanced with subtle oak, fine ripe tannins and good palate length.

SERVE WITH: Beef, lamb or vegetable dishes.
