2013 SEMILLON SAUVIGNON BLANC

BLEND: 70% Semillon 30% Sauvignon Blanc

REGION: Central Ranges, NSW

HARVEST: 22nd & 25th February 2013

WINEMAKING: Sauvignon Blanc & Semillon were harvested as separate parcels at different ripeness levels. These were clarified following pressing then cool fermented separately.

Post ferment parcels were clarified straight up to preserve bright fresh fruit characters; the parcels were then blended, stabilised and prepared for bottling.

BOTTLED: July 2013

WINEMAKER: Debbie Lauritz. B Ag. Sci. [Oen]

APPEARANCE: Pale with green edges

AROMA: Lifted and bright with citrus and passionfruit notes.

PALATE: Citrus notes contribute to full fruit weight on the palate with a crisp, dry finish.

SERVE WITH: Anything! In particular as an aperitif, with seafood, or a crisp summer salad.
