VINTAGE: Slightly warmer than average however consistently cool nights, compressed harvest window
ALCOHOL: 13.5%
TOTAL ACIDITY: 5.67 grams/litre

COLOUR: Deep Garnett
BOUQUET: Concentrated, satsuma plum, mulberry, forest fruits
PALATE: Soft with juicy plums, cherries, provincial herbs and velvety fine tannins

SOIL: Ancient lithosol over red podzolic clay
