Wild Oats Western Australia Sauvignon Blanc displays succulent juicy tropical fruits in a refreshing, vibrant wine. Perfect for a beach picnic or seafood BBQ with friends.

WINEMAKING NOTES:

Individual parcels were harvested and pressed off skins quickly then fermented cool to retain freshness and aromatic purity. The three region blend is deliberate, with each component adding its own character to the blend: Pemberton for structure and fresh aromatics, Frankland for purity and minerality and Margaret River for riper tropical notes.
